**Resolution 20-2008-09**

**IN THE MATTER OF THE REDUCTION OF DISCONTINUANCE  
OF CLASSIFIED SERVICES FOR THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR**

**WHEREAS,** due to the lack of work and/or lack of funds, the Governing Board of the Piedmont Unified School District ("District") hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the District that, as of the 30th day of June 2009, certain classified services now being provided by the District be reduced or discontinued as follows:

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Superintendent of the Piedmont Unified School District is authorized and directed to give notice of termination of employment to the affected classified employees, pursuant to District rules and regulations as well as the applicable provisions of the Education Code of the State of California, not later than forty-five (45) days prior to the effective date of layoff as set forth above.
