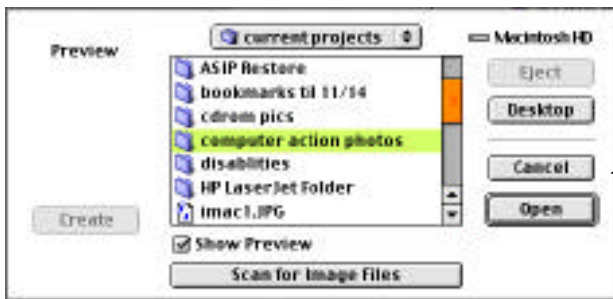
Making an easy slideshow using JpegView

JpegView can take digital photographs stored in one folder and run them automatically as a slideshow. Great for open house!



Open Jpegview

1. Go to the hard drive and open the applications folder.
2. Find JpegView in its folder and double-click to open it.
3. JpegView may want to look at a picture, so navigate to your folder of pictures and pick one, or just hit cancel.



Set Up the Slideshow

1. Under File, go to the Slideshow options.
2. Select the folder Jpegview should use for the slideshow. All the photos you want to run should be in here.
3. You can play around with the settings if you want (random, how long the picture is up etc.).
4. View the slideshow by clicking "begin"
5. Once you it set up, Jpegview will remember your selections and all you have to do on Open House night is select "Begin slideshow".
