## 2016-17 *Connected Learning 1:1* Responsibilities

### I understand the *School's* responsibilities include:

- providing a Chromebook to each student in grades 6-12.
- providing CIPA compliant web-content filtering at home and school
- ensuring access to loaner equipment and repair support
- providing reliable and robust WiFi access to the Internet while on campus.
- ensuring assistance at a Helpdesk and email support via [chromebookhelp@piedmont.k12.ca.us](mailto:chromebookhelp@piedmont.k12.ca.us).
- providing students opportunities to use the device to support their learning while at school.

### I understand that *students* are:

*responsible for the following:*

- treating my Chromebook and others' as I would my own personal property.
- transporting my Chromebook to and from school in the school-provided protective case.
- leaving the PUSD asset tags on my Chromebook intact.
- abiding by the PUSD Responsible Use Policy

*expected to do the following:*

- charge my Chromebook preparation for the next school day.
- bring my Chromebook to school each day.
- protect the device from damage.
- leave intact the operating system and management software installed by the school.

*able to do the following:*

- use the Chromebook to help organize myself and pursue my studies.
- download apps from the Chrome Web Store to help with my studies.
- decorate the Chromebook *case* to help make it my own.

### I understand that as a *parent* of a student receiving a Chromebook from the PUSD:

*my family's responsibilities include:*

- ensuring my child is aware of the student responsibilities as outlined above.
- ensuring my child reports repair needs/damage to the Chromebook Helpdesk - [chromebookhelp@piedmont.k12.ca.us](mailto:chromebookhelp@piedmont.k12.ca.us).
  - PUSD will repair damage up to the depreciated value of the device.
  - families are responsible for the depreciated value of the device in cases of loss or irreparable damage.
