Town Hall Purpose and Facilities Decision-Making

The purpose of the Town Hall meetings is to solicit feedback on the range of options for the new high school facilities funded under Measure HI. The content at each Town Hall will be the same.

After the Town Hall Meetings, District staff will take the input received at Town Halls and through the online survey and present this feedback and recommendations to the Board. The Board will likely make a decision on facilities design in May.
